#### **CO<sub>2</sub> Reduction**

We've already achieved a great deal in the field of CO<sub>2</sub> reduction in 2021, but we've also made a major commitment to improving our CO<sub>2</sub> footprint in 2022, both through product development and innovation and increasing the sustainability of our processes at our production locations.

#### Enhancing transport sustainability

Our vehicle fleet will be further improved by replacing fossil fuel-driven transport with electric vehicles. This applies to both private cars and lorries.

#### Energy saving

We'll achieve even greater energy savings by extending the use of LED lighting and energy-efficient machines. We're also responding to increased awareness in society by using energy sparingly.

#### Waste recycling

In 2021 we achieved 65% waste recycling. And for 2022 we're raising that goal further, to 70%.

#### **Ecocable label implementation**

In 2022 Prysmian Group will become the first cable manufacturer in the Netherlands to introduce its own Ecocable label: an unique environmental quality mark for our products, meaning they comply with high environmental standards during their entire life cycle.
